

Gas Affordability Program

Great Plains Natural Gas Co. offers its Minnesota customers a Gas Affordability Program (GAP). GAP helps qualified customers manage their monthly gas heating bills and pay past-due balances.

A volumetric surcharge paid by Great Plains' residential and general service customers funds GAP. The current surcharge rate of \$0.03399 per dk was approved in 2023.

On August 14, 2024, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission approved Great Plains' request to increase its GAP funding which results in an increase of the surcharge rate to \$0.05218 per dk to continue the GAP for Minnesota customers who qualify. Residential and general service customers will see the increase of the surcharge beginning with gas service provided on or after September 1, 2024.

Great Plains customers who receive federal energy assistance may qualify for two types of credit:

- Monthly Affordability Credit for current natural gas charges
- Matching GAP installment Credit for past-due natural gas charges
